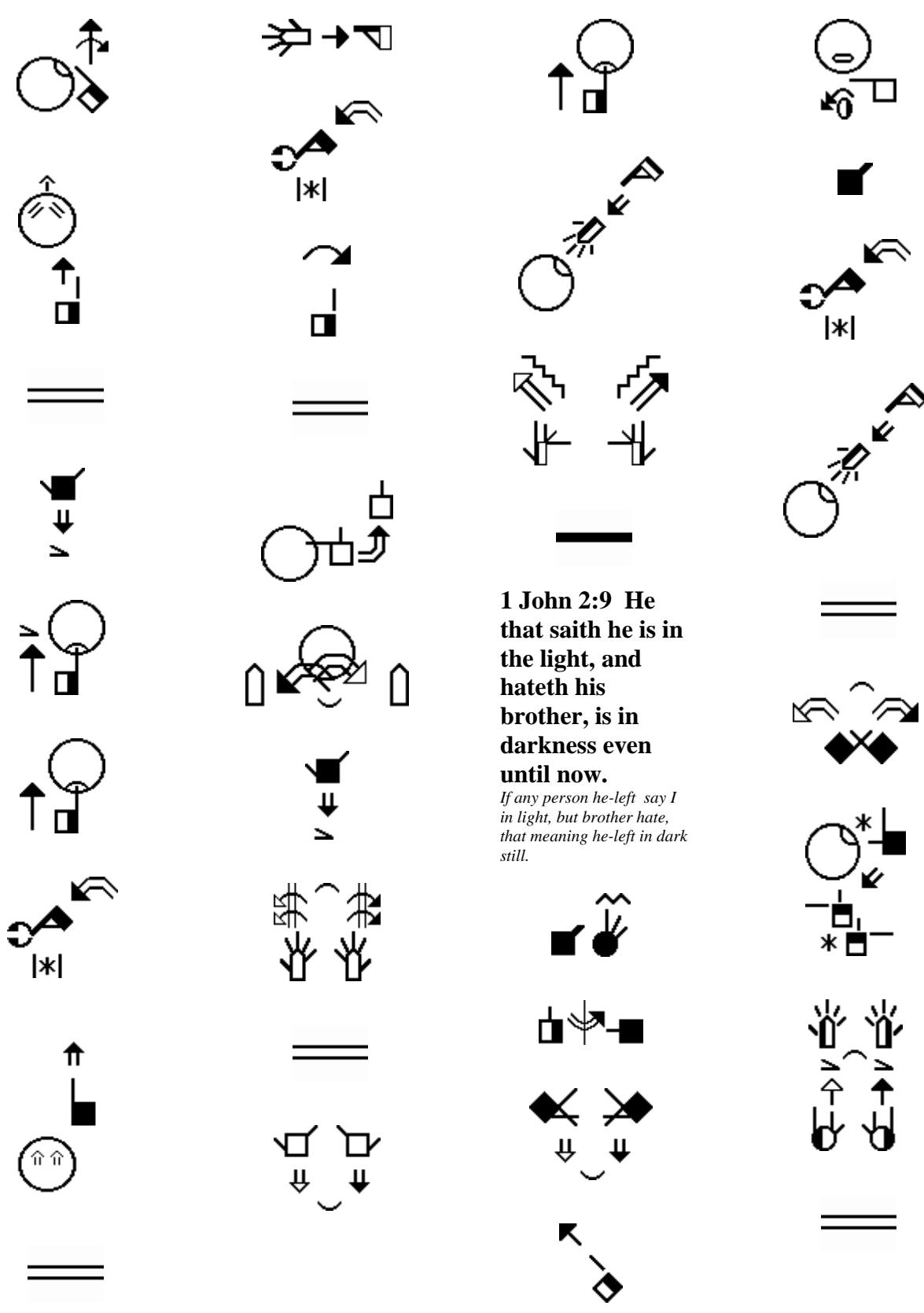
My family, I write to all-you not new command, but old command, same all-you have from past. Old command all-you know already, from past.

shineth.

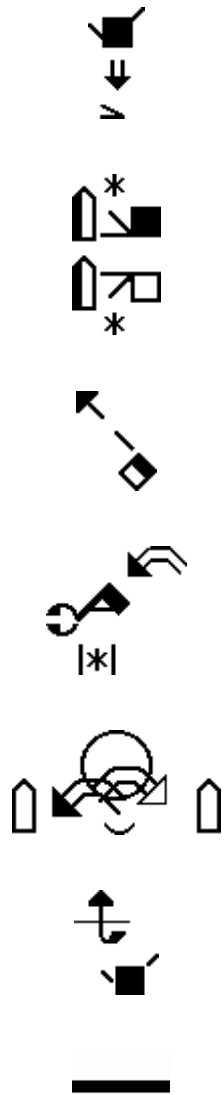
Again new command I write for you, that command true in He-above, and in all-you, because dark that finished, now true light shine.





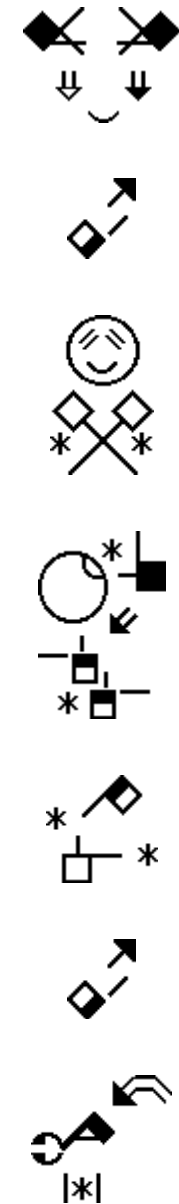
1 John 2:9 He that saith he is in the light, and hateth his brother, is in darkness even until now.
