
THE HOPE IS NOT THE KINGDOM'S RESTORATION BUT THE KING'S RETURN.


Wanting what God wants is spirituality. God's purpose is His kingdom and He wants His kingdom full of righteous people. Wanting the King should be our desire.



Acts 1:6 When they therefore were come together, they asked of him, saying, Lord, wilt thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel?


Our questions reveal our hearts. The apostles were Jews. They thought their problem was Rome, not sin or Satan.

Don't ask, When God?" Ask, "What God?"




7 And he said unto them, It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath put in his own power.

Faith is not knowing all the answers but being satisfied with the answers we have. Trusting is more precious than knowing.





Not good-bye, but a command, and if we are to please Him, that is what we must be.




10 And while they looked stedfastly toward heaven as he went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel;
