


## THE BASIC GOSPEL MESSAGE-THE PURPOSE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

Previously, we learned that miraculous languages spoken by the disciples were the beginning of the outpouring of the Holy Spirit predicted by the prophet Joel. Next Peter reminded his audience that they knew Jesus was sent by God and that the Lord's




The Holy Spirit's power attracted the crowd; the Holy Spirit's anointing spoke to their hearts; and the Holy Spirit's prophecies convinced them.


Jesus Christ now confronted the same crowd that He was alive, the Lord of all and they needed to make a decision.

Revelation 2:4 Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee, because thou hast left thy first love.




