Acts 8:18 And when Simon saw that through laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Ghost was given, he offered them money,

Simon saw or heard something after the apostles laid their hands on people. What? Offering money for religious power or authority is evil.

19 Saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost.

Some people want power badly and they're willing to spend money to get it. We can be sure that Simon's intentions were greedy. There are many people that use religion to make a profit for themselves. They sell the gospel instead of giving it freely. These kinds of preachers are always begging for money. Churches need money to operate, but they give what they have for free.

The Bible does not say if Simon received the Holy Ghost but he definitely saw or heard something that was supernatural. Immediately, Peter perceived a bad spirit within Simon. A person who is right with God would never want to sell God's gift.


22 Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee.

When:


After the Day of Pentecost, before Saul's conversion

Peter rebuked Simon for thinking the power of the Holy Ghost can be bought.







