# RELIGION OR RELATIONSHIP OR BOTH?

Often when Christians witness they will say, "You need a relationship, not religion." They are right, but only partially. People need both. We need the right kind of religion to have the right kind of relationship.

## Religious legalism

Ac 26:5 Which knew me from the beginning, if they would testify, that after the most straitest sect of our religion I lived a Pharisee.

The world has many religion, Christian and Judaism being among them.

### **Religious terrorism**

Ga 1:13 For ye have heard of my conversation in time past in the Jews' religion, how that beyond measure I persecuted the church of God, and wasted it.

Some religionists think they are just to persecute people of other religions.

### Religious traditionalism

Ga 1:14 And profited in the Jews' religion above many my equals in mine own nation, being more exceedingly zealous of the traditions of my fathers.

Sometimes religious traditions contradict the Word of God.

### Vain religion

Jas 1:26 If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's religion is vain.

Hypocrisy undermines the name of Christianity. Gossips give the word religion a bad reputation. They don't even know their religion is vain.

#### Pure religion

Jas 1:27 Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world.

If a person's religion does not teach them to help, and teach them to be holy, what profit does that religion have?

#### Religious relationship

2Co 5:18 And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation;

Right religion begins with reconciliation with God. Reconciliation does not nullify religion but re-directs it the way God wants. Relationships are not for religion but religion is for relationships. Ours is not a rule religion but a relationship religion.

God wants people to have a right relationship with Him. The religion the Bible describes teaches us how to have a right relationship with God, others, and nature. This relationship cannot begin until a person accepts Jesus Christ as his Savior.

Colossians 1:21 And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled

22 In the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unreproveable in his sight:
