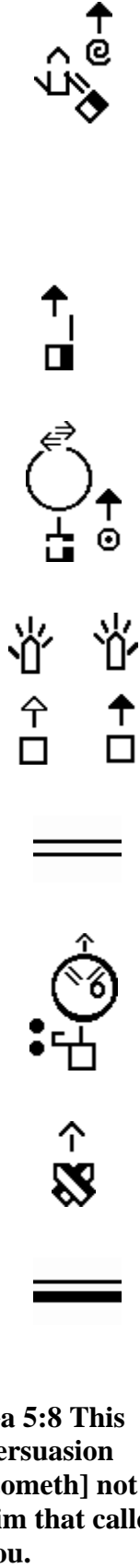
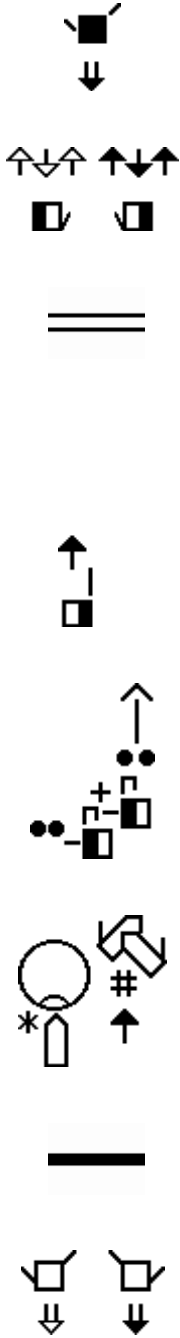


Ga 5:7 Ye did run well; who did hinder you that ye should not obey the truth?

That race, you run good. Now truth you not obey, who block?



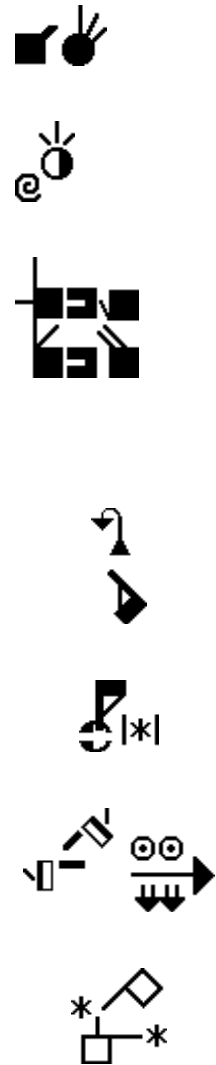
Ga 5:8 This persuasion [cometh] not of him that calleth you.

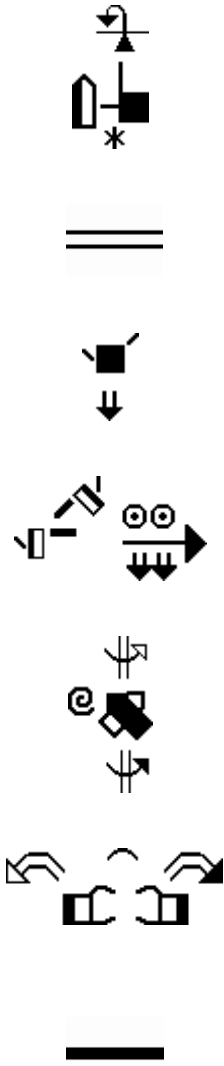
That idea not from He-above, He-above you summon.

If tiny lea ven put in bread then later, that bread become large.

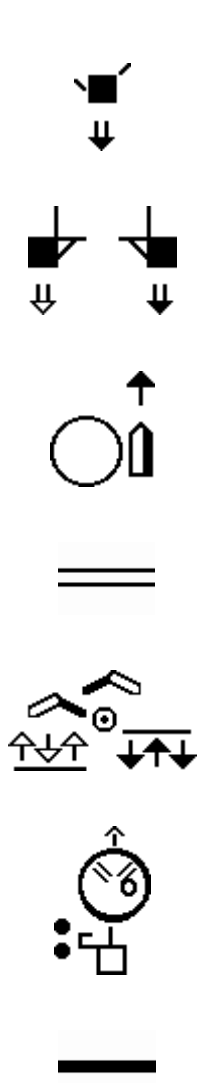




Ga 5:10 I have confidence in you through the Lord, that ye will be none otherwise minded: but he that troubleth you shall bear his judgment, whosoever he be.

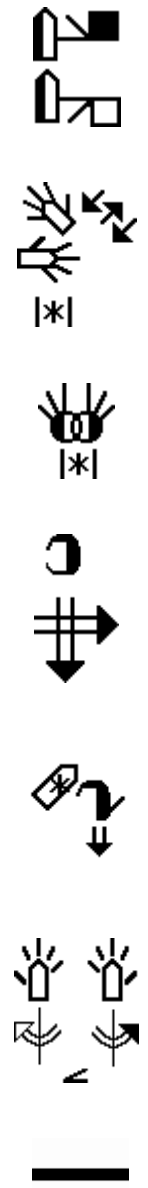
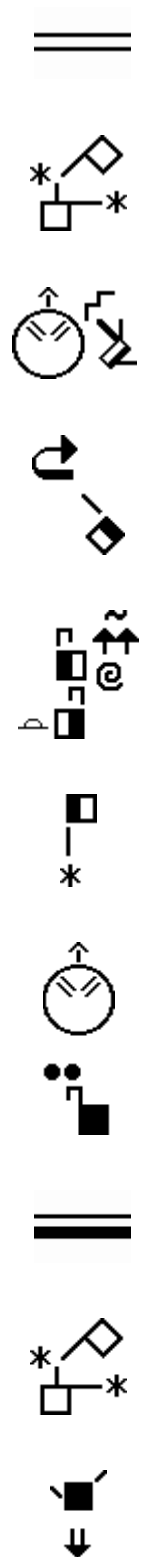
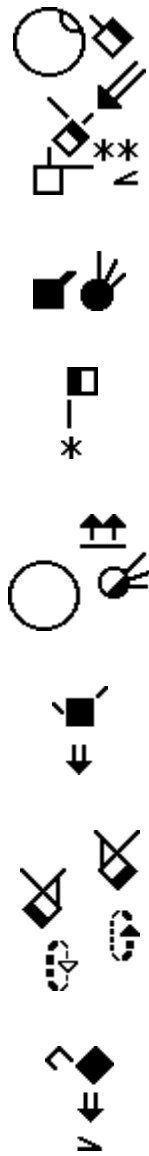
He-above Lord cause me think sure about you. That false way you follow not, have correct mind you. That person confusion you, God judge that person will, no-matter who.
