*If during business or trade person cheat, He LORD say that bad sin, but if person honest, God enjoy.*

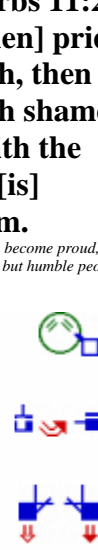


*Honest people know right way, that their guide, but bad people stray, that destroy agent.*

*If any person become proud, will come shame, but humble people wise.*

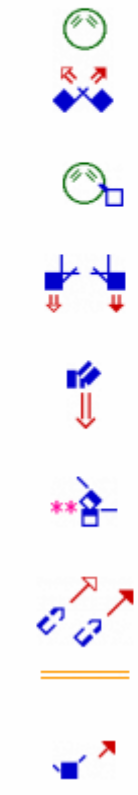


**Proverbs 11:3**  
**¶ The integrity of the upright shall guide them: but the perverseness of transgressors shall destroy them.**



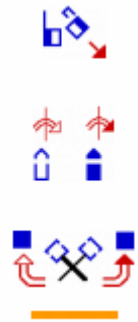


**Proverbs 11:4**
