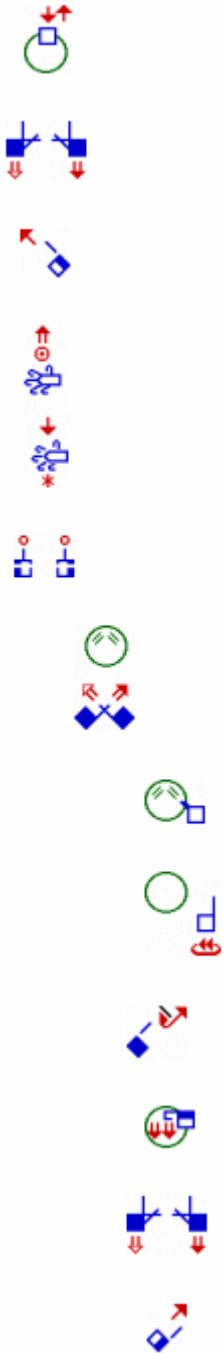


Pr 12:16 ¶ A fool's wrath is presently known: but a prudent [man] covereth shame.

Stupid person he upset quick blow-up, but if someone insult wise person he calm.



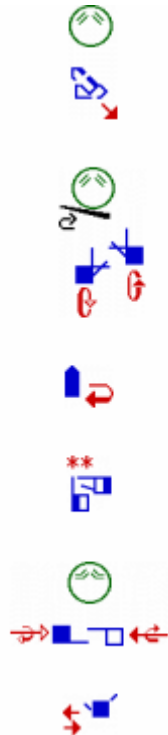
Pr 12:17 ¶ [He that] speaketh truth sheweth forth righteousness: but a false witness deceit.

He person talk truth, that show right way, but he words false he deceive.



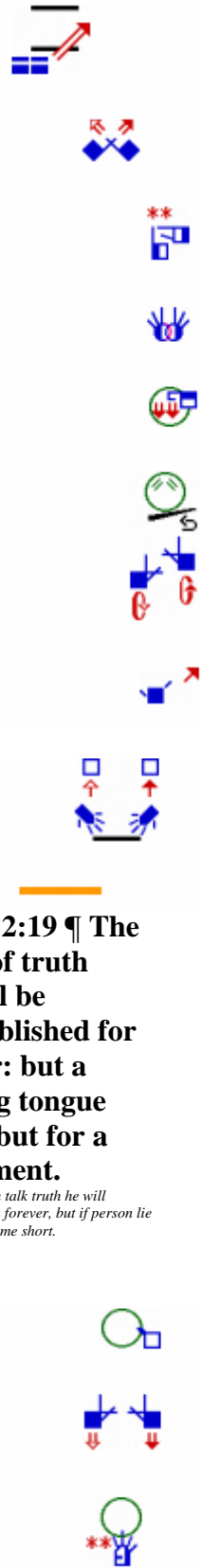
Pr 12:18 ¶ There is that speaketh like the piercings of a sword: but the tongue of the wise [is] health.
