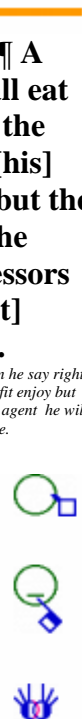
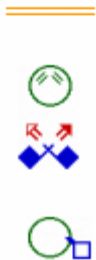
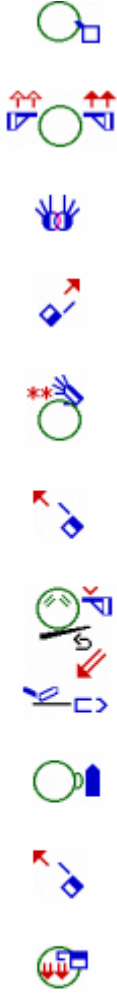


**Pr 13:1 ¶ A

have much trouble.*

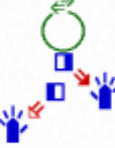




Pr 13:4 ¶ The soul of the sluggard desireth, and [hath] nothing: but the soul of the diligent
