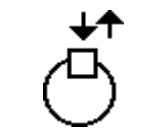
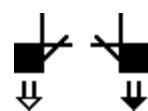
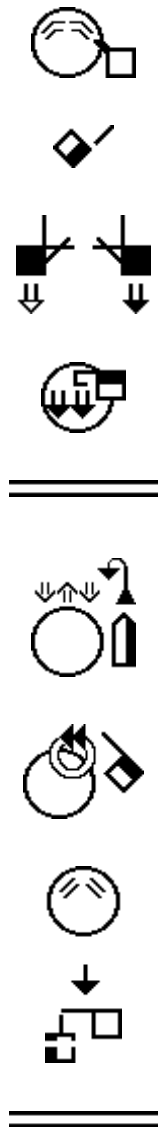


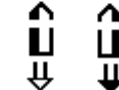
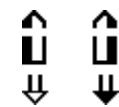
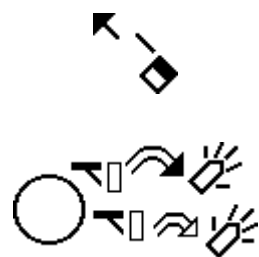
**Pr 13:16 ¶ Every prudent [man] dealth with knowledge: but a fool layeth open [his] folly.**

**Pr 13:17 ¶ A wicked messenger falleth into mischief: but a faithful ambassador [is] health.**

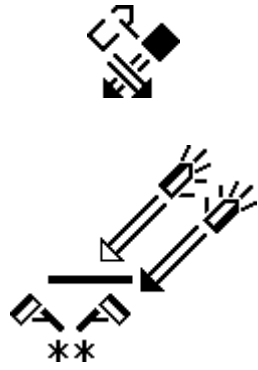
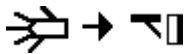
*He message agent evil, he will have problems, but if person he faithful represent agent, that health.*



**Pr 13:18 ¶ Poverty and shame [shall be to] him that refuseth instruction: but he that regardeth reproof shall be honoured.**

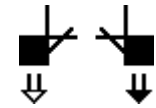
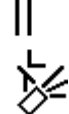
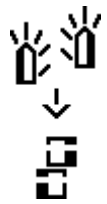
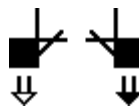
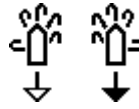
*If person he instruction refuse, will have embarrass and poor will. But he if criticism accept understand, he will have honor.*
