If person good, then will leave inheritance for his grandchildren and treasure of sinner will give to right people.




































Pr 13:23 ¶ Much food [is in] the tillage of the poor: but there is [that

When poor people work, that farm food grow much, but money disappear, why? Other people take-advantage.































Pr 13:24 ¶ He that spareth his rod hateth his son: but he that loveth him chasteneth him betimes.
