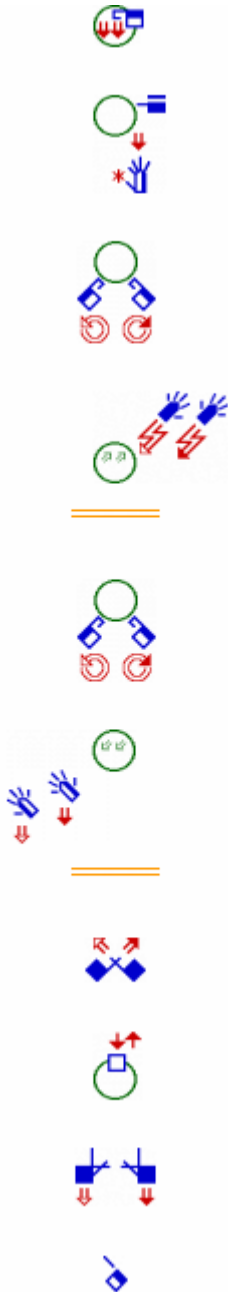


Pr 14:16 ¶ A wise [man] feareth, and departeth from evil: but the fool rageth, and is confident.
