

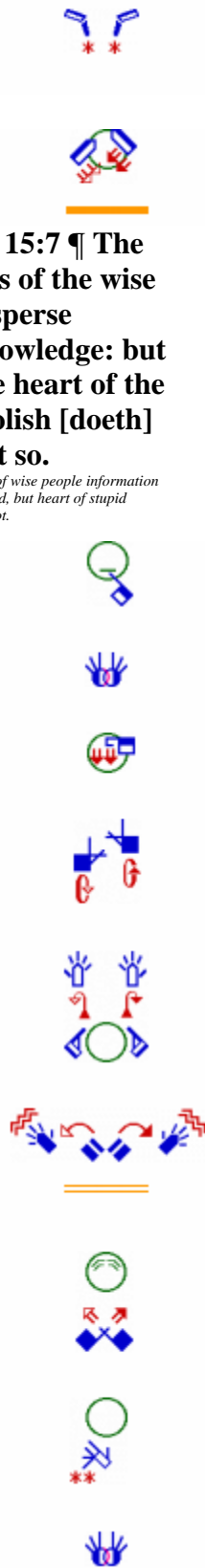
Pr 15:6 ¶ In the house of the righteous [is] much treasure: but in the revenues of the wicked is trouble.

Family of good people have much treasure but income of wicked people have trouble.



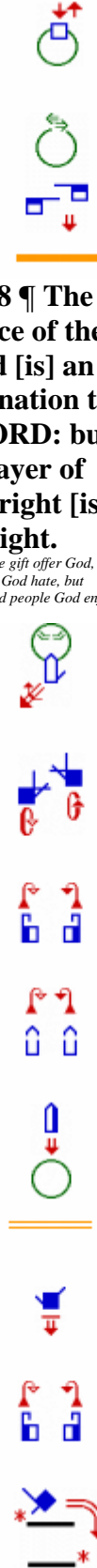
Pr 15:7 ¶ The lips of the wise disperse knowledge: but the heart of the foolish [doeth] not so.

Pr 15:8 ¶ The sacrifice of the wicked [is] an abomination to the LORD: but the prayer of the upright [is] his delight.

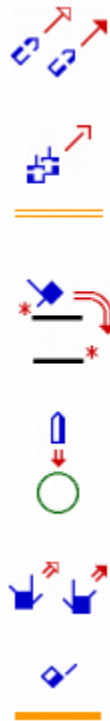
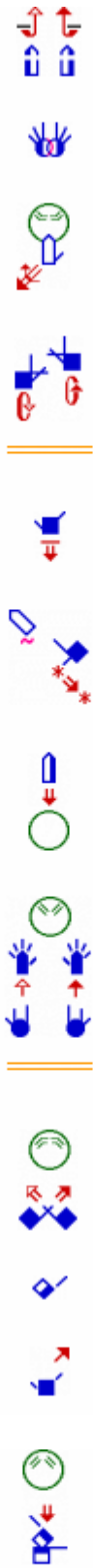
Wicked people gift offer God, that gift Lord God hate, but prayer of good people God enjoy.
