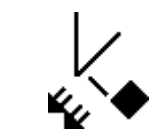
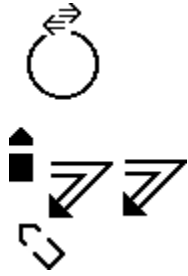
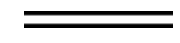
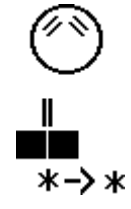
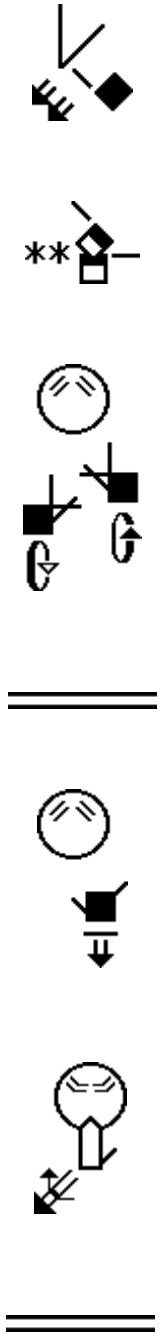


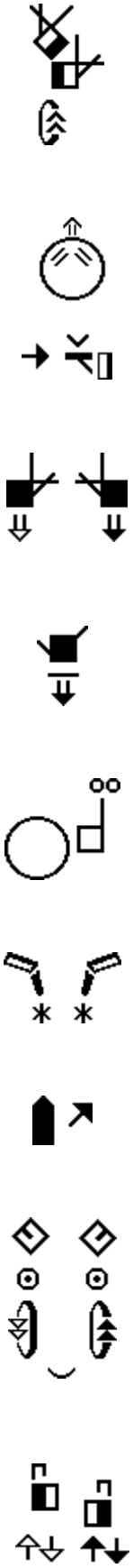
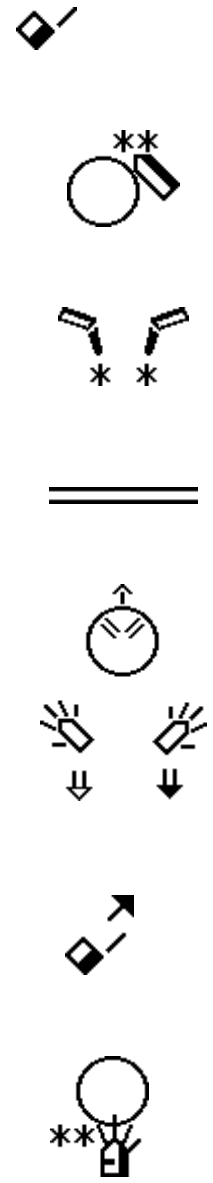
Pr 17:26 ¶ Also to punish the just [is] not good, [nor] to strike princes for equity.
