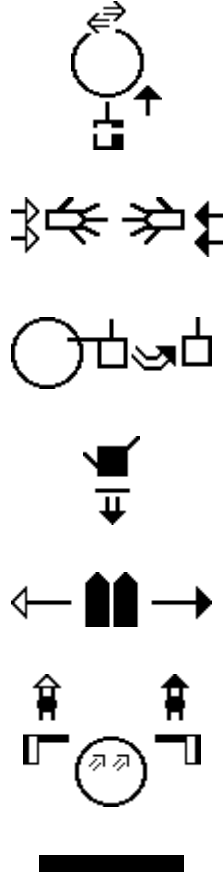
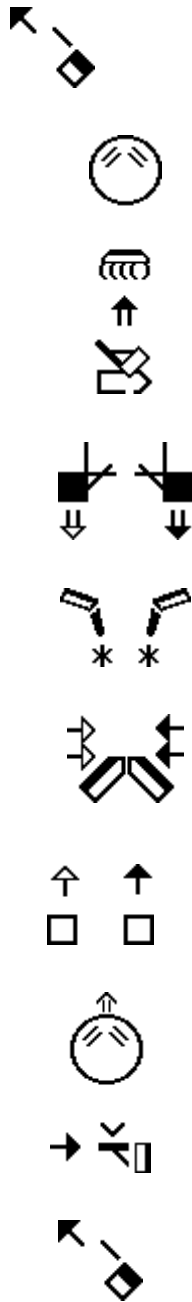


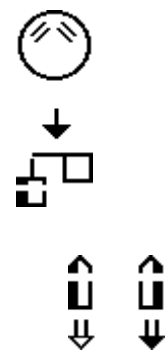
Pr 18:11 ¶ The rich man's wealth [is] his strong city, and as an high wall in his own conceit.

He rich person have city strong and he not afraid because that wall high.



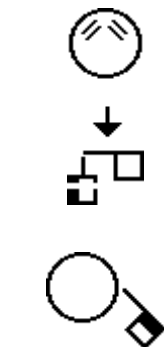
Pr 18:12 ¶ Before destruction the heart of man is haughty, and before honour [is] humility.

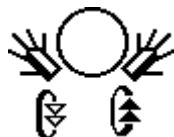
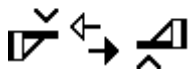
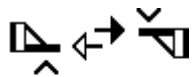
First agent become haughty later come destroy. Also first person humble later come honor.

First listen story situation all, say nothing. Why, if answer before listen, will you have shame and embarrass.

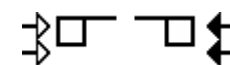
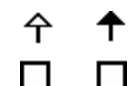
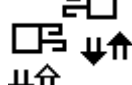
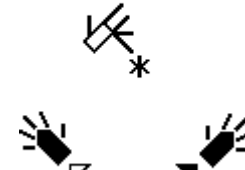
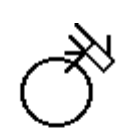


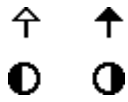


Pr 18:14 ¶ The spirit of a man will sustain his infirmity; but a
