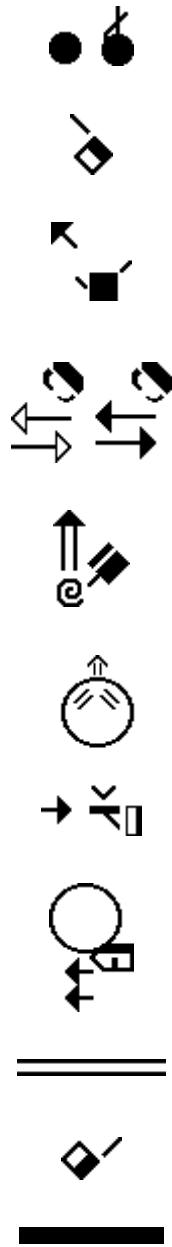


Pr 19:1 ¶

 fool.

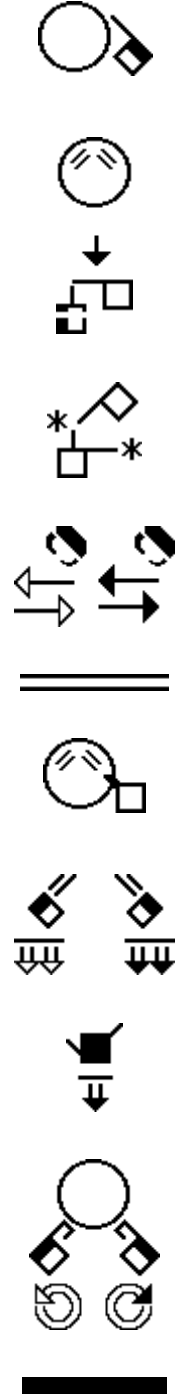
*Which better he poor but action

 hasteth with

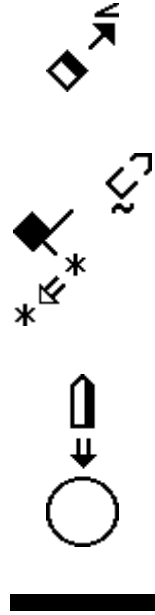
[his] feet

 action, if hurry that sin.*



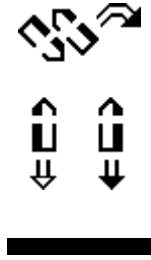
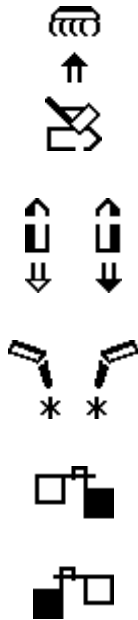
Pr 19:3 ¶ The
