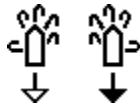
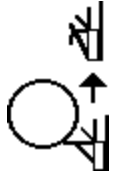
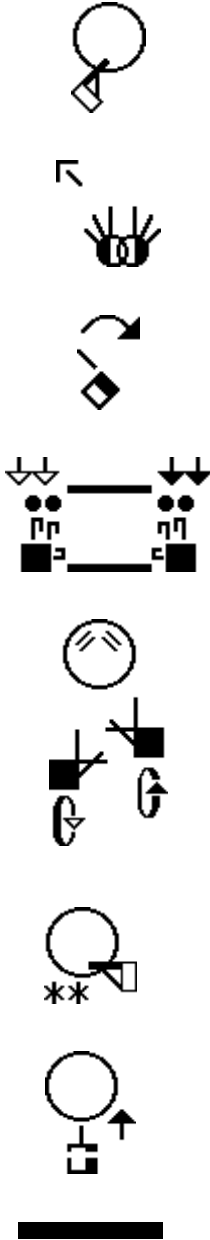


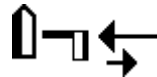
Pr 23:6 ¶ Eat thou not the bread of [him that hath] an evil eye, neither desire thou his dainty meats:
