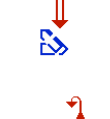
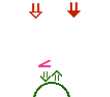
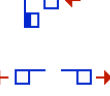
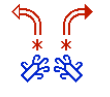
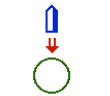
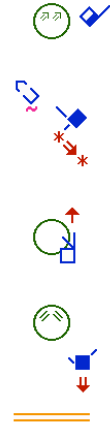
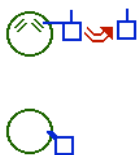
**Rejoice not

from him.

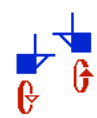
Because if He Lord see that, He enjoy not, then God anger to enemy stop.

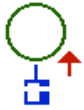

the wicked;**

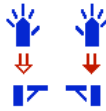
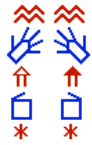
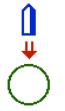
Evil people them envy not, also rebel people join not.





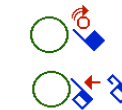
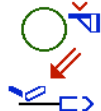
Proverbs 24: 20
