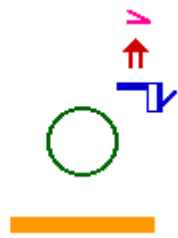
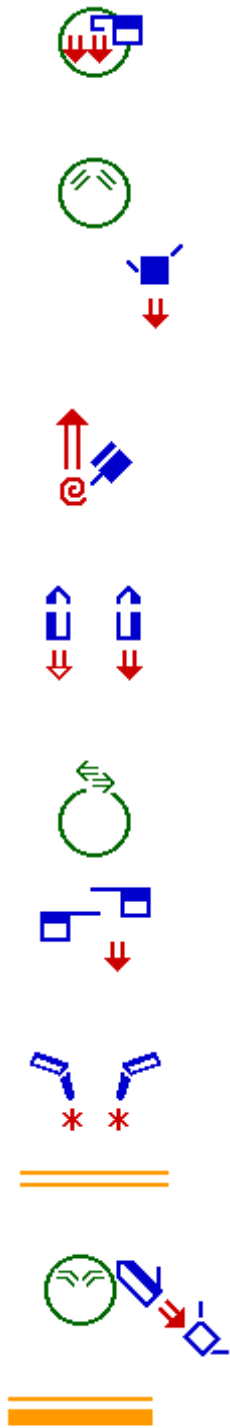


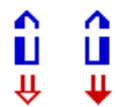
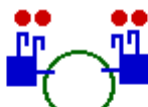
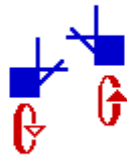
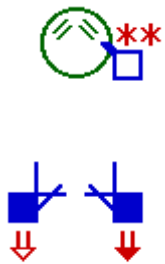
Pr 24:7 ¶ Wisdom [is] too high for a fool: he openeth not his mouth in the gate.

Wisdom that pride agent cannot have, why? High. At the gate he pow.



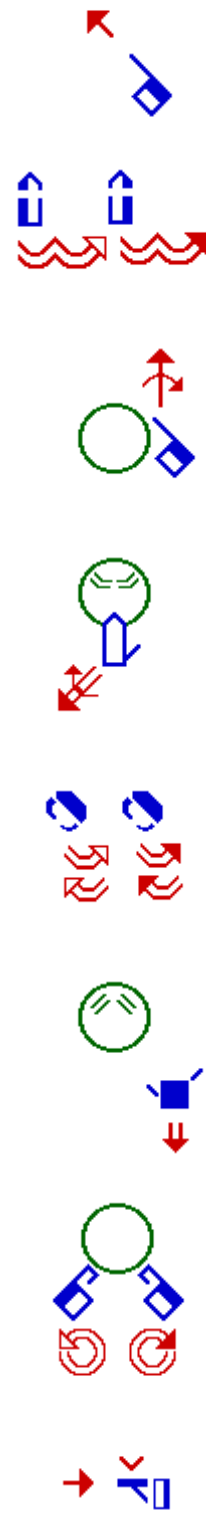
Pr 24:8 He that deviseth to do evil shall be called a mischievous person.

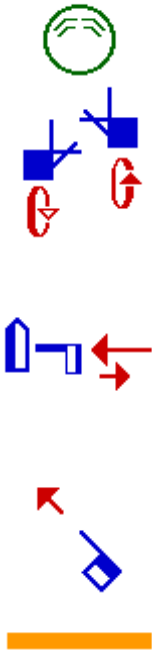
If person create evil plan people call him devil agent

During time of trouble if you faint that means you weak person.

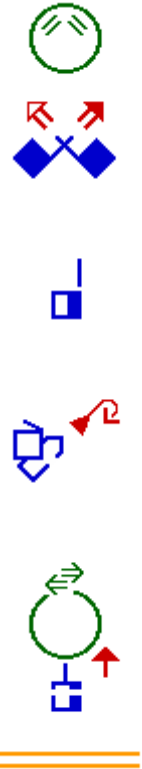
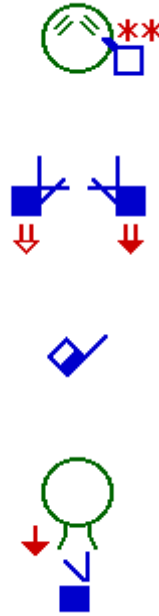


Pr 24:11 ¶ If thou forbear to deliver [them that are] drawn unto
