

Pr 26:21 [As] coals [are] to burning coals, and wood to fire; so [is] a contentious man to kindle strife.

There fire, if add more wood or more coal fire become large, same if there argue wrong agent cause worse, because he not love peace.




Pr 26:22 The words of a talebearer [are] as wounds, and they go down into the innermost parts of the belly.

Gossip agent story cause hurt other people, hurt their heart deep.




Pr 26:23 \P Burning lips and a wicked heart [are like] a potsherd covered with silver dross.
