

Proverbs 27: 21 \P As the fining pot for silver, and the furnace for gold; so is a man to his praise.

Fire pot for clean silver and furnace for clean gold, same praise for clean he man.




Proverbs 27:22 ¶ Though thou shouldest bray a fool in a mortar among wheat with a pestle, *yet* will not his foolishness depart from him.


If you strong punish he stupid agent, no matter, he still silly continue.




Proverbs 27:24 For riches are not for ever: and doth the crown endure to every generation? Why, rich continue eternal not and ask think crown generation continue, no.




Proverbs 27:25 The hay appeareth, and the tender grass sheweth itself, and herbs of the mountains are gathered.
