

### Proverbs 28:11 $\P$ The rich man *is* wise in his own conceit; but the poor that hath understanding searcheth him out.

He rich agent think pride think me wise but the poor agent study him, know he not wise.




# Proverbs 28:12 $\P$ When righteous *men* do rejoice, *there is* great glory: but when the wicked rise, a man is hidden.

When righteous person succeed people celebrate but when wicked people succeed other people hide.




## Proverbs 28:13 $\P$ He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whose confesseth and forsaketh *them* shall have mercy.
