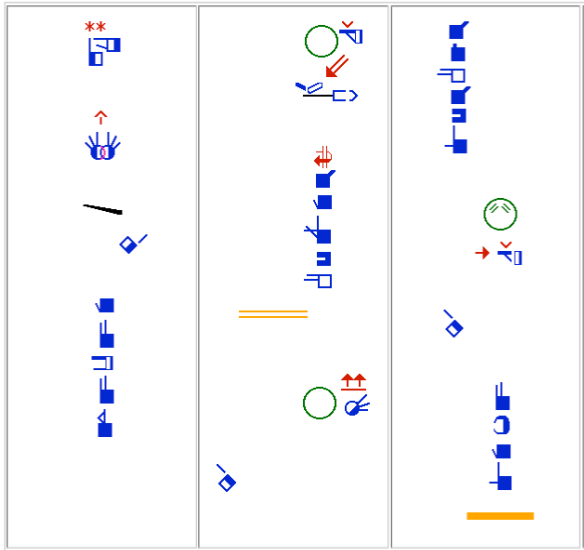


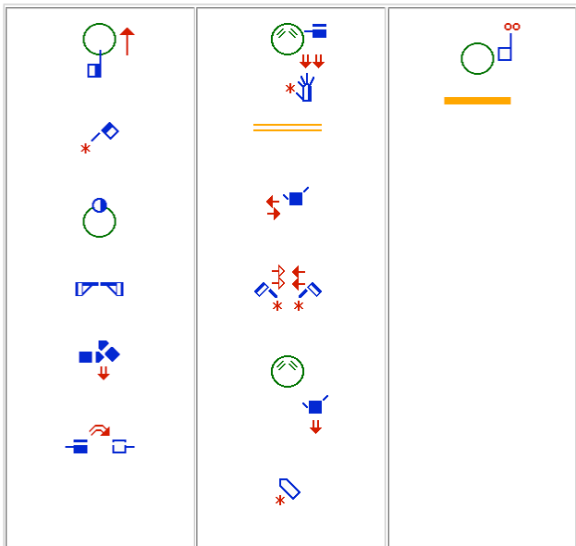

Words of he Augur son of Jakeh, preach he Ithiel and Ucal.



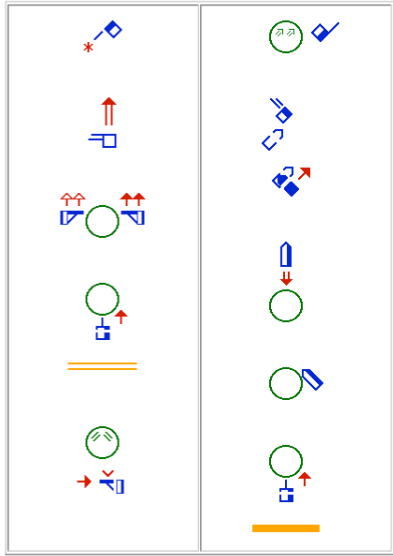
Proverbs 30:2 Surely I am more brutish than any man, and have not the understanding of a man.

Really me ignorant more than other men, like animal that my understanding.



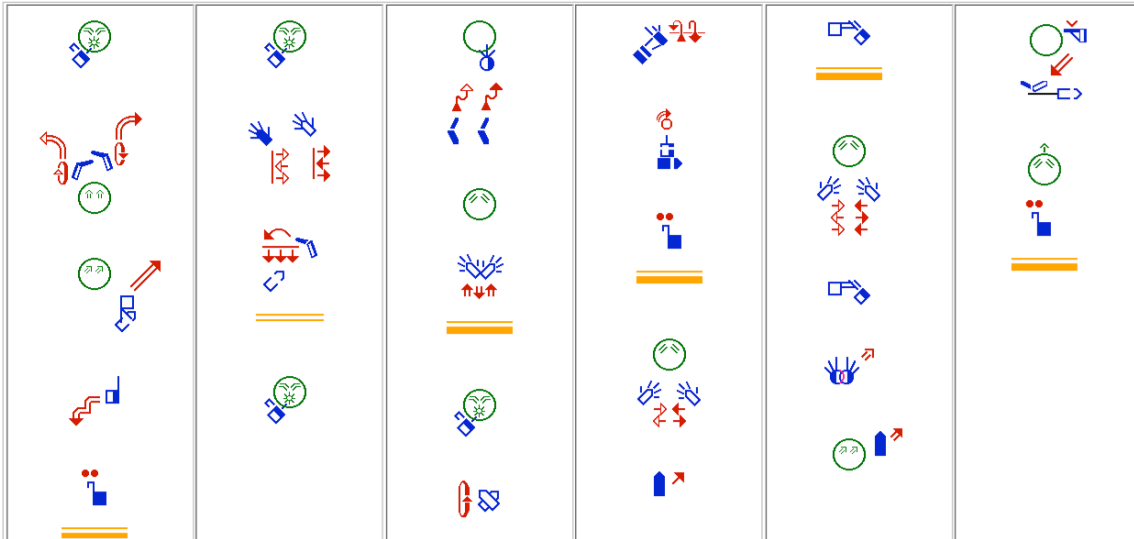
Proverbs 30:3 I neither learned wisdom, nor have the knowledge of the holy.

Me high education not, and He Holy God know not.



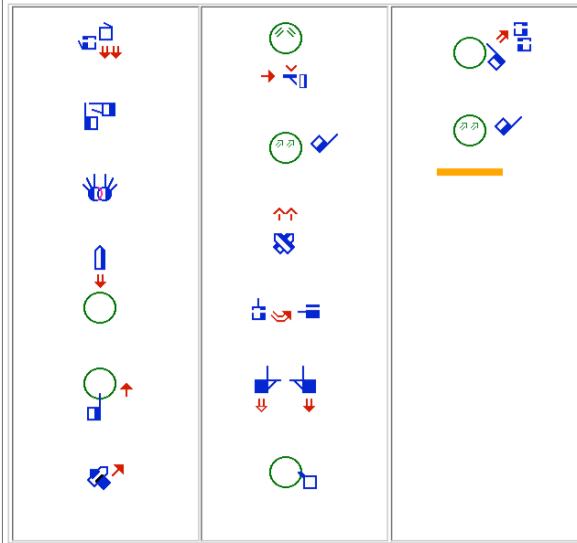
