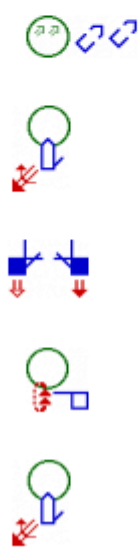


Pr 6:12 ¶ A

mouth.

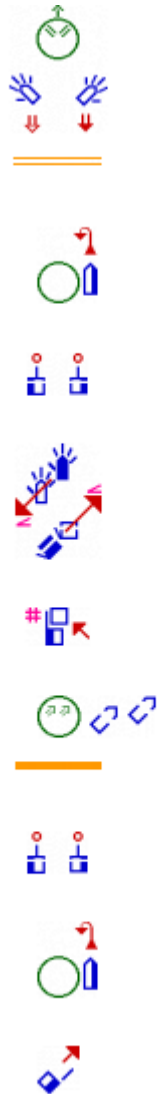


Pr 6:13 He
