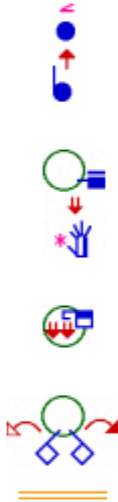


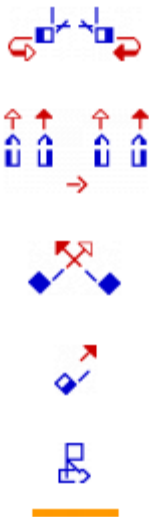
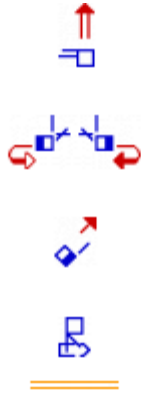
**Pr 8:1 ¶ Doth not wisdom cry? and understanding put forth her voice?**

**Pr 8:4 Unto you, O men, I call; and my voice [is] to the sons of man.**

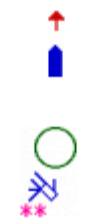
*O men I call, my voice to son of men.*

**ye fools, be ye of an understanding heart.**

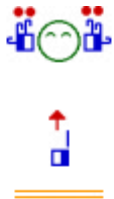
*O ignorant people need wisdom understand, you proud people, your heart must understand.*
