
Pr 8:1 ¶ **Doth** not wisdom cry? and understanding put forth her voice?

Truth my mouth say. Evil things I hate.






















All word of my mouth that correct, nothing wrong, or astray, good words.

That person if have understand mind then wisdom clear, and that person will have know of correct words.
















Pr 8:10 Receive my instruction, and not silver; and knowledge rather than choice gold.
