
WALKING IN THE SPIRIT IS PURPOSEFUL ACTION

9. Don't pretend love other people. Really honestly love them. Wrong things, hate. Things good support.



Being judgmental is not spirituality. Being sensitive, considerate, respectful, honest and sincere is. The prove of spirituality is where you put yourself on your priority list.


Don't try to justify your lack of affection by another person's behavior. Following Jesus is not waiting until your feelings change but deciding to do what God wants.


