
### TREASUREST UP WRATH UNTO THYSELF?

#### God has a record of all that we do.


Romans 2:5 But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God:

## Romans 2:6 Who will render to every man according to his deeds:




6 All people He judges will. How according their deeds done.

# Romans 2:7 To them who by patient continuance in well doing seek for glory and honour and immortality, eternal life:




7 Those people doing good actions continually, seek actions continually, seek holiness, honor, eternal life, things God offers, eternal life He gives will.

Romans 2:8 But unto them that are contentious, and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath,




But people they living for themselves, truth they refuse obey, instead they live wickedly. God His anger poured them will.

# Romans 2:9 Tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that doeth evil, of the Jew first, and also of the Gentile;




9 All people those continuing doing wickedness, so, trouble, terrible happenings they experience will. Jews first, also non-Jews.
