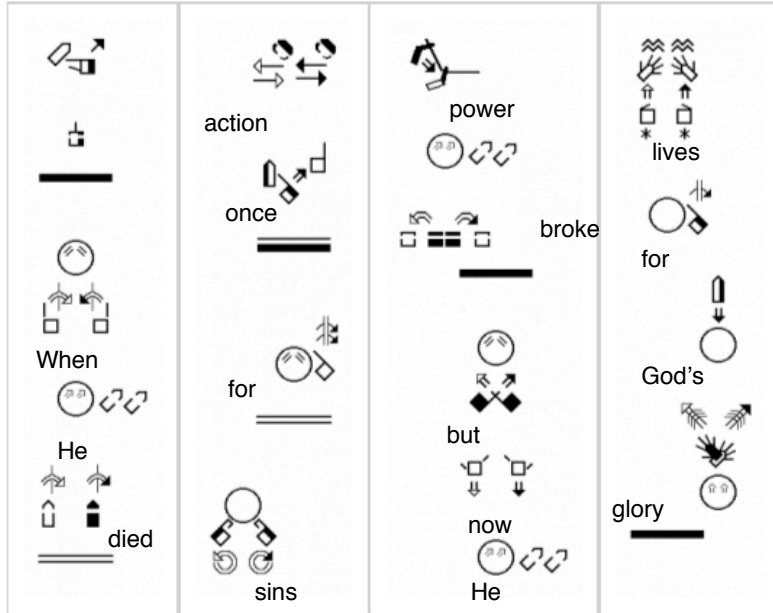


## WHY DO PEOPLE STILL SIN?

**Romans 6:10** For in that he died, he died unto sin once: but in that he liveth, he liveth unto God.

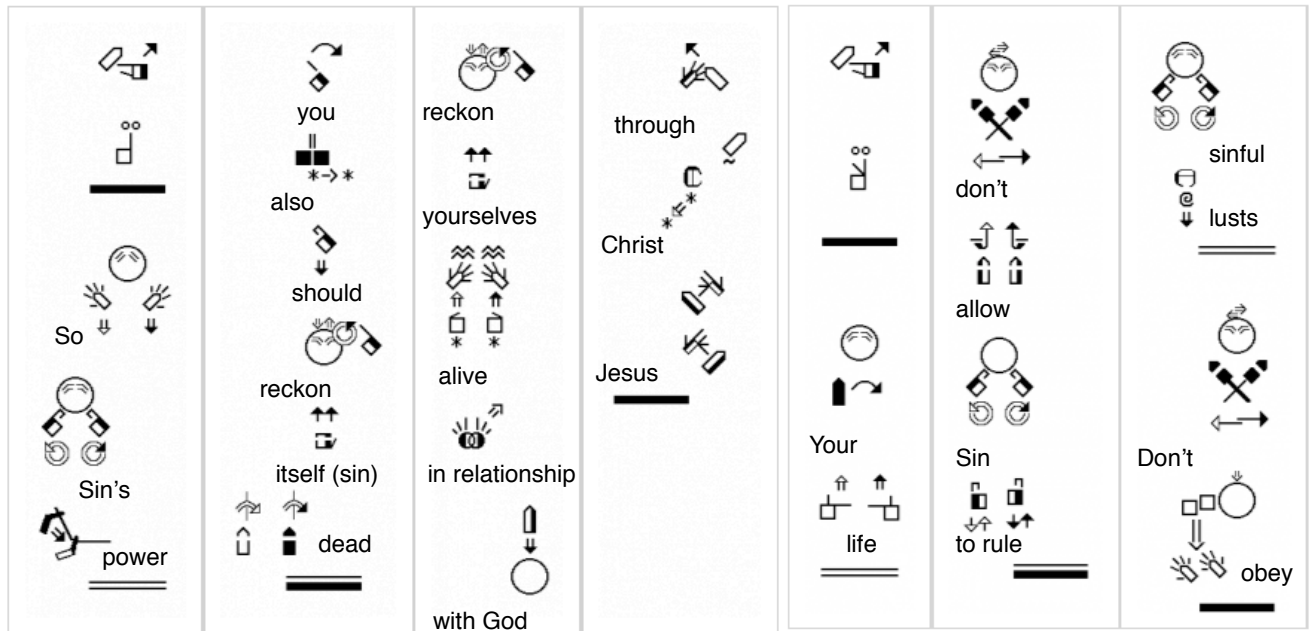

**12** Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof.



*"Reckon" think, consider, conclude, credit, the opposite of feeling. (My boss told me I had to work mid-nights. I feared him; I felt he had a right; but I had a Union book.) God's Book says that Sin has no authority over me, but I must speak up, pray, and exercise my rights.*
